The Solar on Multifamily Affordable Housing (SOMAH) program provides financial incentives for installing photovoltaic (PV) energy systems on multifamily affordable housing. Participating contractors are required to hire **paid** job trainees to work on SOMAH projects. Work opportunities start at 40 hours per project.
