

Request for Energy Efficiency Compliance Milestone Postponement

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the SOMAH PA recognizes that on-site energy audits and upgrades may not be feasible in order to protect the health and safety of low-income residents, property staff, and contractors. As a result, during the COVID-19 crisis, projects that have received Reservation Request Approval may request to postpone the Energy Efficiency Compliance (EEC) Milestone. Until further notice, submission and approval of this request form serves as a temporary postponement of required EEC Milestone documentation and allows an Applicant to move forward to the Proof of Project Milestone (PPM) before completing the EEC Milestone.

By requesting to postpone the EEC Milestone for a SOMAH application, Host Customers and participants acknowledge the following:

- **All required EEC Milestone documentation must be submitted at or before the Incentive Claim (IC) Milestone.**
- The Solar Sizing Tool (SST) is a required document in the EEC Milestone Package and identifies the maximum system size appropriate for the site based on annual site load and no-cost energy efficiency measures that can be deployed on the site. The maximum eligible incentivized solar PV system size will be based on the information provided in the Solar Sizing Tool (SST), including if submitted at IC Milestone review.
- Delaying the completion and submittal of the SST and sizing a solar PV system based on historic consumption alone establishes risk, including the potential for the SOMAH incentive to be reduced based on EEC Milestone results. Additionally, a system designed without SST considerations can create a financial risk (for example, excess solar PV credits relative to future common area consumption if energy efficiency measures are deployed).
- The SOMAH program can provide technical assistance at no cost to the Host Customer, Applicant and/or Contractor to help mitigate these potential risks and ensure the system size is in line with any energy efficiency opportunities or load growth additions that the SST would apply.
- In order to confirm the accuracy of the submitted EEC Milestone documentation, the SOMAH program may conduct future site verifications at their discretion once COVID-19 restrictions are lifted, and Host Customers must assist in coordination of such verification, if necessary.

To postpone the EEC Milestone for a SOMAH application, the Host Customer must sign and date this form. The Applicant should submit this form into the PowerClerk application no later than the original EECM due date.
